

ORDINANCE NO. 2020-04-13-03

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE VILLAGE OF SHEFFIELD MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 16, DIVISION 10 TO PROVIDE AMENDMENTS RELATING TO ABANDONED VEHICLES & INOPERABLE VEHICLES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF SHEFFIELD:

SECTION 1: Chapters 16-10-1: DEFINITIONS is hereby amended by replacing the definition of "Inoperable motor vehicle" means any motor vehicle from which, for a period of at least seven (7) days, the engine, wheels, or other parts have been removed, or on which the engine, wheels, or other parts have been altered, damaged, or otherwise so treated that the vehicle is incapable of being driven under its own motor power. A motor vehicle shall also be considered inoperable if it does not a) display both front and rear registration plate or b) upon which is displayed an Illinois registration plate or registration sticker after the termination of the registration period for the plates or registration sticker or c) after the expiration date set under 625 ILS 5/3-414 and 625 ILCS 5/3-414.1 or any other pertinent IL statute.

SECTION 2: Chapters 16-10-2: PARKING AND STORAGE PROHIBITED: is hereby amended by replacing the entire paragraph as follows: Inoperable motor vehicles may not be parked, stored, or left in the open on private property unless it is necessary for the operation of a business enterprise lawfully conducted thereon. Any vehicle stored under a tarp for more than 10 days will be in violation of this ordinance and subject further penalty as stated in the Village Code.

SECTION 3: If any section or part of this Ordinance is held invalid, it shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall take effect 10 days after publication thereof as provided by law.

SECTION 5: The Village Code of the Village of Sheffield, as amended by this Ordinance, shall remain in full force and effect and all previous amendments to the Village Code shall remain in force and effect except as modified by this Ordinance.
