

ORDINANCE NO 2020-08-10-01

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE VILLAGE OF SHEFFIELD
MUNICIPAL CODE - SAID MUNICIPAL CODE BEING
ORDINANCE 01-07-02-01
LOCATED IN CHAPTER 14, DIVISION 2
OF THE VILLAGE OF SHEFFIELD
TO PROVIDE AMENDMENTS RELATING TO
SIDEWALK AND CURB REPLACEMENT

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF
THE VILLAGE OF SHEFFIELD:

SECTION 1: Chapter 14-2-1 of the Village Code of the Village of Sheffield is hereby deleted in its entirety and a new 14-2-1 of the Village Code is hereby added:

**14-2-1 SIDEWALK/CURB CONSTRUCTION PARTIAL
REIMBURSEMENT BY THE VILLAGE**

- A. In the event that any person, firm or entity desires to have the Village pay for a portion of the replacement of any sidewalk and/or curb adjacent to their property, the provisions of this subchapter must be complied with. Any sidewalk and/or curb that an applicant desires to have replaced shall first be inspected by a representative of the Village who shall either be the Chairman of the Street Committee and/or the Street Superintendent of the Village
- B. The purpose of the inspection shall be for the Village to independently determine if the sidewalk and/or curb needs to be replaced. In the event that the Village determines that the sidewalk and/or curb needs to be replaced, then the applicant may have the sidewalk and/or curb replaced. The Village, if approval is obtained in advance, shall remove, if requested by the applicant, any broken concrete provided that the concrete is broken into pieces that are small enough to be lifted and loaded with a backhoe. All other costs of removal and installation of a new sidewalk and/or curb shall be paid by the applicant subject to the reimbursement provisions as hereinafter set forth.
- C. Following the replacement the sidewalk and/or curb shall be re-inspected by the Street Chairman and/or Street Superintendent to determine the exact amount of lineal feet that was replaced and to determine that the provisions of this chapter were otherwise complied with. Upon re inspection, the Village shall reimburse the applicant for a portion of the sidewalk and/or curb replacement in an amount as determined from time to time by the Board of Trustees.

SECTION 2: SECTION 14-2-2: DRIVEWAYS is renumbered to 14-2-3

SECTION 3: A new Section 14-2-2 is hereby added:

SECTION 14-2-2: SIDEWALK/CURB RESTRICTIONS AND SPECIFICATIONS

All sidewalks and/or curbs constructed in the Village now or hereinafter, including sidewalks and/or curbs for which reimbursement is not sought under the subchapter, shall comply with the restrictions set forth in this Section. : All sidewalks shall be four inches thick except for sidewalks located at driveways and alleys which shall be six inches thick, no less than four feet wide and and curbs will be a standard B6-12. In addition, the most recent version of Class SI concrete per article 1020 of the IDOT Standard Specifications State of Illinois for road and bridge construction in Illinois, hereinafter referred to as "standard specifications", shall apply to all sidewalk and/or curb work.. The standard specifications, currently Article 1020, shall govern type of concrete, sub-grade preparation, forms, placing, finishing, expansion joints curing and protection. Wheelchair ramps shall be provided at all abrupt changes in grade on sidewalks and/or at all locations in which the sidewalk intersects with the curve of the street or roadway at a crosswalk. Wheelchair ramps shall be constructed in accordance with the section of the standard specifications that set forth the standard for wheelchair ramps. All such curb ramps shall be in conformance with the requirements of the Americans With Disabilities Act and any and all other federal and state law now or hereinafter adopted that are applicable to ramps in the Village. No person, firm or entity shall be entitled to any reimbursement for any sidewalk and/or curb not constructed in accordance with the foregoing standards and specifications. All sidewalks and/or curbs that are replaced within the Village, even if the person, firm or entity that replaces the sidewalk and/or curb does not receive reimbursement from the Village shall comply with the standard specifications of the State of Illinois and with the requirements of the Americans With Disabilities Act. Failure to comply with such requirements shall subject the violator to the general penalty provisions of Chapter 1, Division 2 Section 6 of the Village Code. In addition, the Village may remove, replace and bill the violator for the cost of removal and replacement of the sidewalk and/or curb that was installed in violation of the standard specifications of the State of Illinois and of the Americans With Disabilities Act.

SECTION 4: SECTION 14-2-3: EFFECTIVE DATE is renumbered to 14-2-4

SECTION 5: If any section or part of this Ordinance is held invalid, it shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Ordinance.

SECTION 6: This Ordinance shall take effect 10 days after publication thereof as provided by law.

SECTION 7: Ordinance No. 01-07-02-01 of the Village of Sheffield, as amended by this Ordinance, shall remain in full force and effect and all previous amendments to Ordinance No. 01-07-02-01 shall remain in force and effect except as modified by this Ordinance.
